

THE RUSH OF '86

On 11 May 1999, the fifth regional meeting of the Kimberley Society took place in Halls Creek. The speaker, Dr Cathie Clement, was in town with Rosemary Rosario and Philip McAllister from the Perth firm of Heritage and Conservation Professionals. Working as a team, the three were preparing a conservation plan for the Old Halls Creek Post Office Ruins.
